Robin hits the target in Alfred **Dunhill Championship**

South African Robin Williams made a dream debut in the Alfred Dunhill Championship as he opened with a seven-under-par 65 to lead the first round of this Sunshine Tour and DP World Tour co-sanctioned tournament by a single stroke at Leopard Creek on Thursday.

Filliams, who claimed his first Sunshine Tour victory in October's Fortress Invitational, showed himself to be more than ready to take the step up to competing against a DP World Tour field on South Africa's number one ranked golf course. "I can always say I shot 65 at Leopard Creek. I'll always have that," said Williams, who leads the duo of South African Jayden Schaper and Spaniard Manuel Elvira who both carded rounds of 66. The two GolfRSA amateurs Christo Lamprecht and Christiaan Maas started extremely well with their rounds of five under par.

On a day that started in the rain and remained cool throughout, Williams did his scoring in the morning and set a clubhouse target that nobody else

"The greens were a lot firmer than I think we all thought they would be after the rain the night before. It was a bit of a surprise, but you just adapt to it. It was pretty fun out there. I took advantage of the par fives and the short holes and I putted well," he said.

Williams has certainly been building to this kind of performance following his breakthrough victory on the Sunshine Tour.

"The last six or seven tournaments on the Sunshine Tour with that win in there gave me a lot of confidence coming into this tournament to know that I've got the game to win out here and compete. It's now just a case of adapting and learning to play courses set up a bit tougher. This is all a learning curve for me in terms of trying to see what my game needs in order to compete at this level. It's about learning to handle my emotions and not just my game in these big events."

















It's also vindicated his decision to come and learn his trade on the Sunshine Tour after being raised in the United Kingdom. Born in Stellenbosch to South African parents from Springbok and Pniel, Williams' father found work in the UK as a dentist and the family moved there when he was eight. He played for the England Boys and Men's teams, competed in the Junior Ryder Cup on the same team as the twins Nicolai and Rasmus Højgaard, and then turned professional in 2021. After a brief stint on the Euro Pro Tour he decided that the Sunshine Tour offered the kind of competitive opportunities his career needed.

But he has plenty of experience lining up behind him, with former champions Christiaan Bezuidenhout and Charl Schwartzel as well as Erik van Rooyen all on four under par.

"The golf course is in the best condition I've ever seen it in. It was a good round for me. The golf course has changed a lot from the one I did so well on. It's definitely tougher so I was happy to shoot 68," said Schwartzel, a four-time winner of this championship.







panish golfers have always had success at Leopard Creek in the Alfred Dunhill Championship, so it was no surprise to see Manuel Elvira near the top of the leaderboard after the first round.

Elvira opened with a six-under-par 66 to place him just one shot off the lead in his first appearance in this prestigious championship.

"It was a lot of fun. The course is beautiful. It's my first time here and you can see the wildlife around the course and it's really enjoyable," said Elvira. His challenge continues a proud tradition

of Spanish golfers in this event. Álvaro Quirós was a winner here in 2006 when he beat Charl Schwartzel for the title

Pablo Martin then won back-to-back Alfred Dunhill Championship titles in 2009 and 2010 to become the first player in history to achieve this before South Africa's Schwartzel matched this in 2012 and 2013.

Then it was the turn of Pablo Larrazabal to triumph on a golf course he said is easily his favourite in the world in 2019. And last year Spain's Adrián Otaegui finished second to Ockie Strydom.

"I guess we like the heat and the good weather. I've played in a few European Challenge Tour events in South Africa as well and the weather has always been really good. It's different because we don't have this type of grass in Spain, especially where I'm from. But we seem to adapt quite well and I hope to keep doing that these next few days."

A win by a Spaniard this week would make them the most successful country in this championship after the South Africans.



Impressive start by GolfRSA amateurs



op GolfRSA amateurs Christo Lamprecht and Christiaan Maas impressed on day one of the Alfred Dunhill Championship as they played their way to within two shots of the lead. Both Lamprecht and Maas signed for first rounds of five-under-par 67.

For Lamprecht in particular, this week represents a unique opportunity to play South Africa's number one ranked golf course as the world's number one ranked amateur.

"It's been a great year for me with a lot of good golf," said Lamprecht, who won The Amateur Championship this year to book his place in the 2023 Open Championship where he shared the lead after the first round.

"It's great to end off a really good year by coming home and playing in front of home crowds. Being part of GolfRSA makes you immensely proud to play in the Alfred Dunhill Championship here at Leopard Creek. The reason why this is one of the best courses in the world is because it's a true championship golf course that, while testing you, is also very fair. If you play good golf it rewards you, and if you hit bad shots it punishes you."

It's been a watershed year for Lamprecht's career and one in which he says he's learnt valuable lessons as he keeps building his game and experience in championships such as this

"Belief is so important in this game. You've got to believe you're good enough and then go out there and work hard enough. And then I've also learnt to have fun. Know your golf game and enjoy it."
